Registration with normal fee until Sunday May 12, 23:59, after that registration at double fee until last possible registration May 16, 23:59. If you own a valid transponder for timekeeping (*MyLaps ProChip FLEX or ProChip Classic*) the transponder number is needed as well.

Registration received no later than Tuesday May 14, 16:00 is included in the seeding (takes place on Tuesday after the UCI's ranking update).

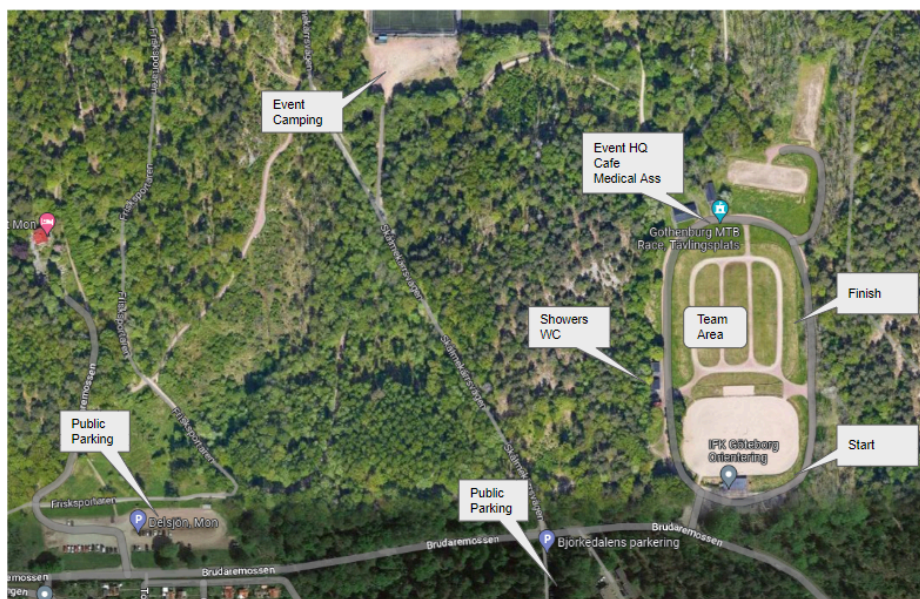

Race HQ

The race headquarter will be located at the event location, situated only 5 km from the city center. The arena has been used for several years for mountain bike races. The 2020 and 2021 Swedish championships in XCC, XCT and XCO were hosted at this arena as well as 2023 Nordic Championship XCO. In the HQ you will find license check, bib, secretariat, accreditation for Tech/Feed Zone, press, anti-doping.

Timekeeping

Electronic timing with transponders will be used for all riders. Valid transponders are MyLaps ProChip FLEX and ProChip Classic. Transponders will be available to rent from the organization at a cost of SEK 150. If you want to rent a transponder, this is booked and paid in Sportstiming.se Collection of transponder will be done when collecting the bib. If the transponder isn't returned, the person will be debited 100 EUR

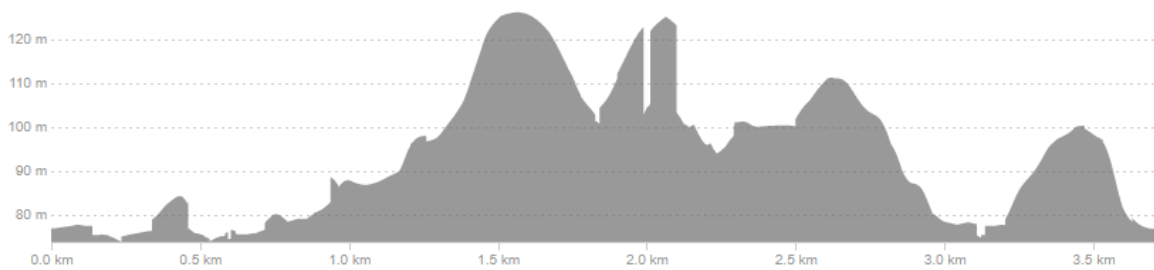
Course

The race will be initiated with a start loop (2,5km) using part of the ordinary track.

Race course is 4 km long with an elevation of about 120m per lap. It consists of technical single track with many rocks and roots, slick rocks and some man made jumps and berms. Since the course is designed in one bigger and two smaller loops the spectators get a good overview over the competitions. It is possible to access most of the places around the track with some favorite spots, like the "SM-droppet", "downhillbanan" and the spectacular "rotbacken".

Application of the 80% regulation
